What services are available?

- full assessment by key worker
- substitute prescribing
- medical assessment
- group information sessions
- one to one key working
- information and advice on harm reduction
- regular saliva testing
- relapse prevention
- advice and information on drug using and its effects
- information on hepatitis and HIV
- Doppler scanning to check liver and vein function

Who provides this service?

The team is made up of medical professionals, key workers and counsellors, supported by an administration team and by volunteer workers. The team can also refer you to other specialist services, such as Drug Intervention and Day Programmes.

Joint working and confidentiality

Our aim is to act in the best interests of the people who use our service. Our holistic approach makes use of all appropriate organisations to offer the best support.

If you are

- aged 16 or over (16-19 year olds are assessed jointly with the Young Persons' Team)
- using or misusing drugs
- at risk of using or misusing drugs
- suffering from drug related harm
- worried about someone else who is using or misusing drugs
- registered with a GP (we can help you find a GP in your local area if you are not registered)
