Our service is for anyone:

- Aged from 10 to 18 years
- Living in the Borough of Ealing
- Who uses or misuses drugs and/or alcohol, or who is at risk of doing so
- Who is experiencing harm from someone else's misuse of drugs or alcohol
- Has misused substances in the past and wants support.
